Walk for Literacy presentation by Roy Buenviaje (Information)

ExEd Report: Cathy Walsh (Information)-

Cathy shared financials and budget analysis for October 2009.

- Actual versus budgeted income had a variance of \$15,963 less than budgeted.
- YTD revenue had a negative variance of \$19,031.
- Expenses are \$34,994 under budget.
- · ADA lower than budgeted. If this decrease continues, there will be significantly less funding for the school

Community Conference Presentation by Norma Chang and Cynthia Mora (Information)- Ms. Chang and Ms. Mora were unable to attend, but sent a PowerPoint presentation for the board to view. The conference would feature Miriam Neninger, a psychologist who has a well-known Spanish radio program. Kang reported that having a workshop with a very good psychologist will help us raise money for our school by inviting her. It will be in Spanish for parents. There will be a \$15 donation per person and the date may be March 11, 2010 from 7-9 pm.

Director Report (Information)

- LdVCS currently has a total of 148 students: K-43, 1st-17, 2nd-22, 3rd-18, 4th-23, 5th-20, 6th-5.
- 11/19 was Make Up Picture day for students and volunteers who were absent on the original date.
- On 11/20, Kang met with Heather Zumbahlen, Coordinator, Special Education and Pupil Services with CVESD to follow up on Special Education services.
- Thanksgiving Break was from 11/23-11/27.
- On 12/2 the Super Dentists provided K-6 classroom with presentations on proper oral hygiene. Students received goody bags.
- A Uniform Meeting was held on 12/3 at 6pm. 16 families present at the meeting are in favor of uniforms for their children. Student uniforms will be discussed at the January 2010 Roundtable Meeting.
- On 12/8 LdVCS held its monthly Fire Drill.
- · LdVCS parent Jodi Brisebois is sharing her art expertise with our students as classes participate in the Air and Space Museum: Airport Art contest.

Audit/Budget- Everly reported about the possibility to grow and take the second floor and about our school calendar.

Curriculum and Assessment-Gannon talked about the new Academic Progress Report. There will be two family nights coming up.

Partnership – Erin Fowler is the new partnership committee chairperson. She shared information about how she plans to structure the partnership committee, including numerous sub-committees, so that the committee can serve its numerous functions. She also updated the board on upcoming buy-back dates.

Providing Guidance to the Governance Committees (Information)-Gannon reported that we need to set guidelines for fundraisers and make sure that we stand by our mission for any partnerships or fundraising we do, including researching the restaurants that we chose. We don't want to send contradictory messages to our families. By holding a fundraiser at a restaurant, we are sending the message that we endorse that restaurant as a healthy place to dine.

MOU with Fleet Science Center (Information)

LdVCS is in the process of establishing a partnership with the Ruben H. Fleet Science Center in Balboa Park. A MOU is being drawn up by the science center. Aspects of the partnership include:

- Science center providing resources and guidance to teachers, including science kits being housed at LdVCS and refilled as needed by the science center.
- LdVCS providing students to help Fleet with teacher inservice programs. Our students would not only participate in the science, but have free admission to the museum as well.
- Opening LdVCS' doors to other teachers in the county to observe science lessons
